

UPON ARRIVING IN BUDAPEST

BY AIR: Participants travelling by air will arrive at Budapest International Airport (BUD, Ferenc Liszt International Airport).

BY TRAIN: Budapest has excellent rail connections to all major European cities. The main train stations are Keleti (Eastern) Railway Station, which handles most international and long-distance trains; Nyugati (Western) Railway Station, serving domestic routes and some international

destinations; and Déli (Southern) Railway Station, primarily used for regional trains heading to the western and southern parts of Hungary. See [here](#).

LOCAL CURRENCY

The currency of Hungary is forint, abbreviated as HUF. 1 EUR is around 400 HUF now.

TRANSPORTATION BETWEEN THE AIRPORT AND BUDAPEST CITY CENTER

We advise considering ecological transportation options whenever possible. On arrival at Budapest Airport, you can use the following transport options to reach Budapest city center.

Access by bus from the airport to Budapest:

Budapest's public transportation system offers a convenient and budget-friendly way to get from Liszt Ferenc International Airport (BUD) to the city center.

- **100E Airport Shuttle Bus:**

Route: Budapest Airport (Terminals 2A and 2B) → City center (stops at Kálvin tér, Astoria, and Deák Ferenc tér)

Duration: Around 35–45 minutes depending on traffic

Ticket Price: 2,500 HUF (approx. €6.5)

Where to Buy Tickets: From the BKK ticket machines at the airport (card or cash) or using the BudapestGO app

Important Note: Regular transport passes or single tickets are not valid on the 100E — you need the special airport shuttle ticket.

- **Bus 200E + Metro Line 3** (If you're looking for a cheaper option)

Step 1: Take Bus 200E from the airport to Kőbánya-Kispest (M3 metro terminal)

Step 2: Transfer to Metro Line 3 (blue line) toward the city center (e.g., Deák Ferenc tér)

Total Duration: Around 50–60 minutes

Tickets Needed: Two single tickets (500 HUF each), or one 90-minutes ticket (850 HUF) - or you can choose for longer time period types, see later

Where to Buy Tickets: From the BKK ticket machines at the airport (card or cash) or using the BudapestGO app

Access by taxi from the airport to Budapest:

- Taking a taxi from Liszt Ferenc International Airport is a convenient and comfortable way to reach downtown Budapest — especially if you are traveling with luggage or arriving late at night. *Főtaxi* is the only authorized taxi company at the airport. The Főtaxi booth is located just outside the arrivals terminal. Fare to the venue from the airport is around 15,000 HUF (40 EUR).

BUDAPEST PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Budapest's public transportation is reliable, safe, and tourist-friendly.

- **Main Types of Transport:**

Metro: 4 color-coded lines (M1, M2, M3, M4) connect key parts of the city. The yellow M1 line is Europe's oldest metro after London's.

Trams: Iconic yellow trams are a scenic and popular way to travel. Tram lines 4 and 6 run 24/7 on the Grand Boulevard.

Buses and Trolleybuses: Cover the entire city, including night buses after regular service hours.

Public bikes: MOL Bubi is an eco-friendly public transport service by BKK. Download MOL Bubi app, register, then buy a pass or Pay As You Go access. In the app, you can check the locations of bike stations. Pick up bikes by scanning the QR code found above the rear wheel.

- **Tickets and Passes:**

Single Ticket: 500 HUF (valid for one ride without transfer)

90-minutes Ticket: 850 HUF (allows changing lines, latest change within 90 min. after start)

24-hour Budapest travel-card: 2,750 HUF (valid for 24 hours on all BKK services)

72-hour Budapest travel-card: 5,750 HUF

Tickets must be validated at the start of your journey using the orange machines or scanned via the mobile app (BudapestGO).
